School Uniforms

All uniforms except the girls blazer and the boys tie must be purchased through our approved uniform provider Global Schoolwear. Visit [globalschoolwear.com](https://www.globalschoolwear.com), you can find our school store using code HAWT01.

All students are required to purchase a daily uniform and a physical education uniform for their grade level.

Please, keep in mind that the uniform can take up to three weeks or more to ship, plan ahead if you are ordering for September.

Uniforms run small, when in doubt size up.

Girls Daily Uniform

Kindergarten, 1st grade and 2nd grade:

- Classic Navy Jumper
- White polo shirt with logo (long or short sleeve)
- White oxford shirt with no logo (only for important dates, portraits or inauguration)
- Burgundy blazer**
- Navy vest with Hawthorn logo can be worn as layering piece
- Solid dark navy knee socks or solid dark navy tights**
- Navy or black leather Mary Jane style shoes



Grade 3:

- Classic Navy Jumper
- White oxford shirt and white polo shirt with Hawthorn logo for warm weather weeks***
- Burgundy blazer**
- Navy vest with Hawthorn logo can be worn as layering piece
- Solid dark navy knee socks or solid dark navy tights**
- Navy or black leather Mary Jane style shoes



Grades 4-8:

- Navy plaid skirt, worn at knee length
- White oxford shirt and white polo shirt with Hawthorn logo for warm weather weeks***
- Burgundy blazer**
- Navy vest with Hawthorn logo can be worn as layering piece
- Solid dark navy knee socks or solid dark navy tights
- Grades K-5: Navy or black leather Mary Jane style shoes**
- Grades 6-8: Flat, Navy or Black, closed toe and closed shoe professional style shoes**



Boys Daily Uniform

Kindergarten, 1st grade and 2nd grade:

- Herringbone pants or shorts
- White polo shirt with logo (long or short sleeve)
- White oxford shirt with no logo (only for important dates, portraits or inauguration)
- Navy blazer with Hawthorn logo
- Long sleeve sweater or vest with Hawthorn logo
- Hawthorn tie** (only for important dates, portraits or inauguration)

Grades 3-8:

- Herringbone pants or shorts
- White oxford shirt with no logo
- White polo shirt with Hawthorn logo can be worn during warm weather weeks***
- Navy blazer with Hawthorn logo
- Long sleeve sweater or vest with Hawthorn logo
- Hawthorn tie**

Accessories*

- All students: solid dark navy knee socks if the student wears shorts or solid navy socks if he wears pants
- All grades: Navy or Black lace up or velcro shoes or loafers
- All grades: black or navy belt



P.E. Uniform

- Navy Crew Neck sweatshirt with Hawthorn logo
- Navy sweatpants with Hawthorn logo
- Navy mesh shorts
- Heather gray t shirt with Hawthorn logo
- Athletic sneakers and socks*



Uniform notes and general dress code requirements:

- (*)Belts, navy socks and shoes may be purchased from other vendors other than Global Schoolwear.
- (**)Girls burgundy blazers and boys ties will be available for purchase through the school, please reach out to Mary Carmen to buy them.
- Both boys and girls blazers will be required to enter and leave school and to attend specific events. The vest or sweaters can be worn as a substitute while in class.
- Skirts and jumpers must have a hem and fall to the top of the knee or below in the front and back.
- No visible undergarments. A white tank top can be worn under white shirts.
- No logos other than the Hawthorn School logo must be worn.
- Backpacks and pencil cases should be solid with no characters.
- For safety reasons jewelry such as chains and necklaces should be avoided. If worn they must be tucked inside the shirt and not visible.
- Students are expected to refrain from wearing any form of makeup, including eye shadow, lipstick, eyeliner, mascara, or dark polish.
- Mud shoes: We encourage students to bring an extra pair of “mud shoes”, a pair of old shoes that can stay in the school and that they can use to play outdoors when the weather is humid or cold.
- (***)All Students can wear their polo instead of the shirts until Columbus day and after May 1st. On special days like the first day of school, inauguration mass, portrait days or special concerts all students should wear the shirt and tie (tie applies for boys only).
- Please note that all uniform items should be clean, neat and in good condition and repair. Students are expected to dress appropriately for school and to adhere to the school’s uniform policy.
